When we think of revolutions, we often envision frantic activity. In 2003, when my world was revolutionized, I was just sitting--sitting at a conference of the Association of Certified Biblical Counselors. I saw that biblical counseling could revolutionize my life and ministry. Since I became certified as a biblical counselor, I have seen the lives of many of Deaf people revolutionized.

Early Christians were accused of upsetting the world; I established Deaf Biblical Counseling (DBC) to overturn the Deaf world by caring for people who are burdened by sin and suffering.

- Around the world, seventy million Deaf people don't know Christ. Because people in many countries have learned American Sign Language (ASL), DBC has a global outreach. ● While 1500 Deaf unbelievers die daily, DBC counselors have the privilege of presenting the gospel to some of those unbelievers.
- Users of the world's more than three hundred signed languages have no Bible translations in their languages. DBC counselors, working from the only complete Bible translation in any of the world's signed languages, can make the Bible accessible to other Deaf people.
- One hundred large American cities have no Deaf churches. In the Deaf churches that have been established, more than forty percent have no pastor. Because DBC requires counselees to participate in churches, we are using Zoom to connect people to Bible-preaching churches.

I am inviting you to join the revolution by partnering with DBC. To meet our goals for 2022, DBC is asking God to provide \$90,000. Your partnership would promote God's glory in the Deaf world by enabling us to:

- Pay a part-time director to train and oversee counselors. As the volunteer director, I am torn between providing for my family and pursuing DBC's gospel opportunities.
- Produce training and counseling materials in ASL. Our international counselees cannot read English. All our counselees benefit from material in their heart language.
- Travel to teach Deaf groups about biblical counseling. In this way, God may raise up more Deaf counselors, save more Deaf unbelievers, and sanctify more Deaf believers.
- Send our counselors for training in key areas, so they can more effectively minister.
